- 1. Champagne Roland Bauchet Brut NV** £38.00

*A favourite of Wine Spectator and Wine Enthusiast, this is a family run house producing solely from their own vineyards. This is 75% Pinot Noir and shows classic toasty, biscuity flavours. (12% abv)*
- 2. Bollinger Special Cuvée NV** £78.00  
*Rich, toasty and full bodied, with wonderful concentration and depth of flavour. (12% abv)*
- 3. Cuvée Dom Perignon Moët et Chandon 2006** £204.00  
*Aromas of acacia honey and fresh almonds, dried apricots and toasted brioche finishing long and elegant. (12.5% abv)*
- 4. Champagne Cristal Louis Roederer** £280.00  
*Elegant, deep, and silky textured with fresh hazelnut and apple scents and flavours. Medium to full bodied with a long finish. (12% abv)*
- 5. Laurent-Perrier Rosé Brut NV** £92.00  
*This salmon-pink rosé Champagne is truly remarkable for its highly expressive bouquet. Made with 100% pinot noir, a finely crafted rosé with both depth and freshness. It has become the benchmark for rosé Champagne around the world. (12% abv)*

*A revolutionary pink fizz, that's super refreshing, not too dry with lovely delicate flavours that will set any celebration alight. (12% abv)*

*Light, dry and crisp with zingy citrus and fruity red berry flavours.

22. **M de Minuty Rose 2015** £26.00  
Château Minuty, St Tropez, Provence, France

*Fruity, zesty and light but dry with bright acidity, its refreshing floral and red fruit aromas are balanced neatly by mineral overtones and a good structure, excellent with shellfish. (13% abv)*

Rioja-Alta, Spain  
*Medium bodied and smooth with blackberry fruit, a touch of earthiness, buttery oak and wild spice. (13.5% abv)*
30. **Apaltagua Reserva Malbec 2014** £27.00  
Apaltagua Winery, Chile  
*Softly fruity with gentle hints of spice; this wine has real charm (14% abv).*
32. **Hoopenburg Shiraz 2013** £23.00  
Stellenbosch, South Africa  
*Vibrant and full-bodied with aromas of redcurrant and peppery spice, followed by a rich, smoky palate of forest fruits and vanilla (13.5%abv).*
33. **Fleurie, Domaine Bouronieré 2014** £29.00  
Beaujolais, France  
*A complex nose of red fruits with floral nuances leading to a supple palate with raspberry fruits leading the way backed up by dried figs and soft tannins. (12.5% abv).*
34. **Château Cruzeau, St Emilion Grand Cru 2011** £35.00  
Bordeaux, France  
*Blend of Merlot and Cabernet Franc, gives a smooth rounded plummy palate with integrated tannins. (14% abv)*

Domaine de la Ville Rouge  
*Intense classic Syrah character with a slight smokiness and spice on the palate; full-bodied (13% abv).*
- 31. Brunello di Montalcino, Abbadia Ardenga 2010** £49.00  
Tuscany, Italy  
*An expressive nose of forest fruits, with an intensely flavoured, full-bodied and velvety palate (14% abv).*

*A lovely nose, expressive and perfumed, with aromas of blackcurrant, tobacco and cedar. This is very open, forward and impressive; moderate concentration on the palate, which is lithe and balanced. (13% abv).*
